

Wash one another's feet	<b>John 13:14</b> If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.
<h1>Love</h1> one another	<b>John 13: 34, 35</b> A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another." <b>John 15:12</b> This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. <b>John 15:17</b> These things I command you, that you love one another. <b>Romans 13:8</b> Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law. <b>1 John 3:11</b> For this is the message that you heard from the beginning, that we should love one another, <b>1 John 3:23</b> And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment. <b>1 John 4:7</b> Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. <b>1 John 4:11-12</b> Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us.
Abound in love to one another	<b>1 Thessalonians 3:12</b> And may the Lord make you increase and abound in love to one another and to all, just as we do to you,
Sincerely love one another Fervently love one another	<b>1 Peter 1:22</b> Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart, <b>1 Peter 4:8</b> And above all things have fervent love for one another, for "love will cover a multitude of sins."
Members of one another	<b>Romans 12:5</b> so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.
Be kindly affectionate to one another Give preference to one another	<b>Romans 12:10</b> Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;
Be of the same mind toward one another	<b>Romans 12:16</b> Be of the same mind toward one another. Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion.
Be like-minded toward one another	<b>Romans 15:5</b> Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus,
Do not judge one another	<b>Romans 14:13</b> Therefore let us not judge one another anymore, but rather resolve this, not to put a stumbling block or a cause to fall in our brother's way.
Edify one another	<b>Romans 14:19</b> Therefore let us pursue the things <i>which make</i> for peace and the things by which one may edify another.
Receive one another	<b>Romans 15:7</b> Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God.
Admonish one another	<b>Romans 15:14</b> Now I myself am confident concerning you, my brethren, that you also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.
Wait for one another	<b>1 Corinthians 11:33</b> Therefore, my brethren, when you come together to eat, wait for one another.
Care for one another	<b>1 Corinthians 12:25</b> that there should be no schism in the body, but that the members should have the same care for one another.
Serve one another	<b>Galatians 5:13</b> For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.
Do not bite and devour, lest you be consumed by one another	<b>Galatians 5:15</b> But if you bite and devour one another, beware lest you be consumed by one another!
Do not provoke one another Do not envy one another	<b>Galatians 5:26</b> Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

<p><b>Bear</b> one another's burdens  <b>Bear with</b> one another in love</p>	<p><b>Galatians 6:2</b> Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ. <b>Ephesians 4:2</b> with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love,  <b>Colossians 3:13</b> bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.</p>
<p><b>Speak the truth,</b>  you are members of one another</p>	<p><b>Ephesians 4:25</b> Therefore, putting away lying, "Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor," for we are members of one another.</p>
<p><b>Be kind</b> to one another  <b>Forgive</b> one another</p>	<p><b>Ephesians 4:32</b> And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.  <b>Colossians 3:13</b> bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.</p>
<p><b>Speak</b> to one another</p>	<p><b>Ephesians 5:19</b> speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,</p>
<p><b>Submit</b>  to one another</p>	<p><b>Ephesians 5:21</b> submitting to one another in the fear of God.  <b>1 Peter 5:5</b> Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."</p>
<p><b>Do not lie</b> to one another</p>	<p><b>Colossians 3:9</b> Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds,</p>
<p><b>Teach</b> and admonish  one another</p>	<p><b>Colossians 3:16</b> Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.</p>
<p><b>Comfort</b>  one another</p>	<p><b>1 Thessalonians 4:9, 18</b>  9 But concerning brotherly love you have no need that I should write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to love one another;  18 Therefore comfort one another with these words.  <b>1 Thessalonians 5:11</b> Therefore comfort each other and edify one another, just as you also are doing.</p>
<p><b>Do not hate</b> one another</p>	<p><b>Titus 3:3</b> For we ourselves were also once foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another.</p>
<p><b>Daily exhort</b> one another</p>	<p><b>Hebrews 3:13</b> but exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin</p>
<p><b>Consider</b> one another  to <b>stir up love</b> and good works  <b>Exhort</b> one another</p>	<p><b>Hebrews 10:24-25</b> And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.</p>
<p><b>Do not speak evil</b>  of one another</p>	<p><b>James 4:11</b> Do not speak evil of one another, brethren. He who speaks evil of a brother and judges his brother, speaks evil of the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge.</p>
<p><b>Do not grumble</b> against one  another  <b>Confess your faults</b> to one another</p>	<p><b>James 5:9, 16</b>  9 Do not grumble against one another, brethren, lest you be condemned. Behold, the Judge is standing at the door!  16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.</p>
<p><b>Have compassion</b> for one  another</p>	<p><b>1 Peter 3:8</b> Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous;</p>
<p><b>Be hospitable</b> to one another.  <b>Minister your gifts</b> to one another.</p>	<p><b>1 Peter 4:9-10</b> Be hospitable to one another without grumbling. As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.</p>
<p><b>Have fellowship</b> with one another</p>	<p><b>1 John 1:7</b> But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.</p>
